All players must report to the Starter at the office near the Pro Shop at least 30 minutes prior to their hit-off time. The field is limited to 224 players. If requested, late nominations will be placed on a waiting list.

### **Competition Rules**

**Note: This event is being played under the auspices of the Queensland Veteran Golf Union.**

- Each competitor must be a financial member of a Veterans' Association or group and hold a current AGU handicap.
- The B.V.G.A. Committee reserves the right to alter or vary the program, divisional handicaps, or any event, if the number of competitors is deemed insufficient for a competition.
- The rules of golf in force at the time and the local rules of Bargara Golf Club shall be the rules of the day. Should there be a dispute or doubt on a rule, a second ball should be played for that hole and a ruling sought later.
- **The competition will be divided into four handicap divisions for men and three for ladies.**
- Each person can only win one divisional trophy. Should scores be tied, the result will be decided by countback.
- Should play be stopped for any reason by the Committee, the completion of nine holes by **ALL** competitors (excluding retirees) is the criteria. If the criterion is met, for the first and second daily competitions, only the first nine holes are counted. If not, the trophies are allocated by a draw.

**Golf Link cards are necessary to register for play and are to be presented to the Starter on check-in. If not held, then a Handicap Card should be available for perusal.**

### **COVID Restrictions**

- The Bargara Golf Club conducts competitions using the COVID 19 Safe Plan Guidance - Queensland Effective 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2020.
- All businesses in the hospitality industry in Queensland must comply with the new electronic contact information requirements. These may include QR Codes, Online fillable forms, Online booking systems and digital spreadsheets. The club uses the QR codes system.
- Player to score his / her own scorecard. Only one signature required. Verbally verify with fellow player your score prior to signing.
- Bunker rakes have been removed.
- Do not handle the flagsticks.
- Social distancing signs will be displayed.
- Hand sanitiser stations are available.
- No hand shaking.
- Water fountains on the course have been made inoperable.
- Entry of the scorecards into the Micropower system be will done by volunteers from the Bargara Veterans Match Committee. A scoreboard for completed morning scorecards will be available at the Proshop. Afternoon scorecards must be handed to a member of the Vets Match Committee up the Clubhouse.
